








### **Digital Space**

**Human's Digital Space** is a kind of **Digital Space**. In our days HDS is a very important property of individual


**Human's Digital Profile** – is an abstract object with subset of properties and subset of methods (procedures). This is a static existence.

**Human's Digital Track**— is an abstract object with subset of properties and subset of methods (procedures). Main properties: coordinates of subject and time. This is a dynamic existence.






#### Conclusion
